- Make sure surfaces to be bonded are clean and dry.
- Ideal storage temperature is 60°F to 80°F with no exposure to direct sunlight.
- · Apply adhesive between 55°F and 85°F.
- Handling and set times may be affected by environmental conditions.
- Read product label for specific directions.
- If filling deep cracks or large knots, we recommend using a layering technique:
- 1. Apply a thin layer of Instant Bond adhesive.
- 2. Spray the adhesive with Instant Bond Accelerator.
- 3. Wait at least 30 seconds, and repeat until crack or knot is completely filled.
