To Whom It May Concern:

This letter has been written to verify the VOC content of <u>Titebond Acoustical Smoke & Sound Sealant</u>. The current VOC content of this product is 45.75 g/L. This is below the VOC content limits of California's South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule #1168 for All Other Architectural Sealants which has a VOC content limit of 50 g/L.

Additionally, Titebond Acoustical Smoke & Sound Sealant has passed California Department of Public Health CDPH/EHLB/Standard Method Version 1.2, 2017 (Emission testing method for CA Specification 01350). This is a requirement for obtaining LEED v4 low emitting materials credit. Please note that the VOC emissions certificate was issued on March 26, 2024.
